Remuneration of Pharmacies

Ordinance 188/2018 – D.R. 124/2018, Series I of 2018-06-29

Amends Administrative Rule 262/2016, of October 7, which regulates the specific remuneration attributed to pharmacies, by dispensing of reimbursed medicines, due to the reduction of reference prices
