## New justified absence period for death of first-degree relatives

The justified absence period following the death of first-degree relative, covered in the Portuguese Labor Code (*Código do Trabalho*), has been amended by Law 1/2022 of January 3.

For the death of first-degree relative, the reform increases the grieving period to 20 consecutive days. For the death of a spouse (if not legally separated), a civil partner, a parent, a person with whom the employee lives, or a first-degree relative in the direct ascending line, the grieving period is five consecutive days.

Following the death of first-degree relative, both parents are entitled to receive psychological support at a Portuguese National Health Service (Serviço Nacional de Saúde) establishment. This psychological support should be available within five days from the death. This right to psychological support is also guaranteed on the death of a close family member such as a spouse or ascendant.
